

## Appraisal Review Board

The Appraisal Review Board (ARB) by law is responsible for hearing and resolving protests from property owners concerning appraisal of their properties. The ARB members are by statute not employees of the Appraisal District, including the Board of Directors. They typically are county property owners selected by the Board of Directors to serve two year terms. The Appraisal Review Board's duties and a property owner's right to protest the appraisal of their property are more thoroughly explained in the pamphlet entitled *Property Taxpayer Remedies*.
